THE ORIGIN OF THE SIGN



The FKS Stal Mielec crest is a symbol of the football club from Mielec, which has a rich history and tradition dating back to the early 20th century. The club was founded in 1939 and since then the club's crest has evolved, reflecting the changes and successes that have accompanied the team over the years.

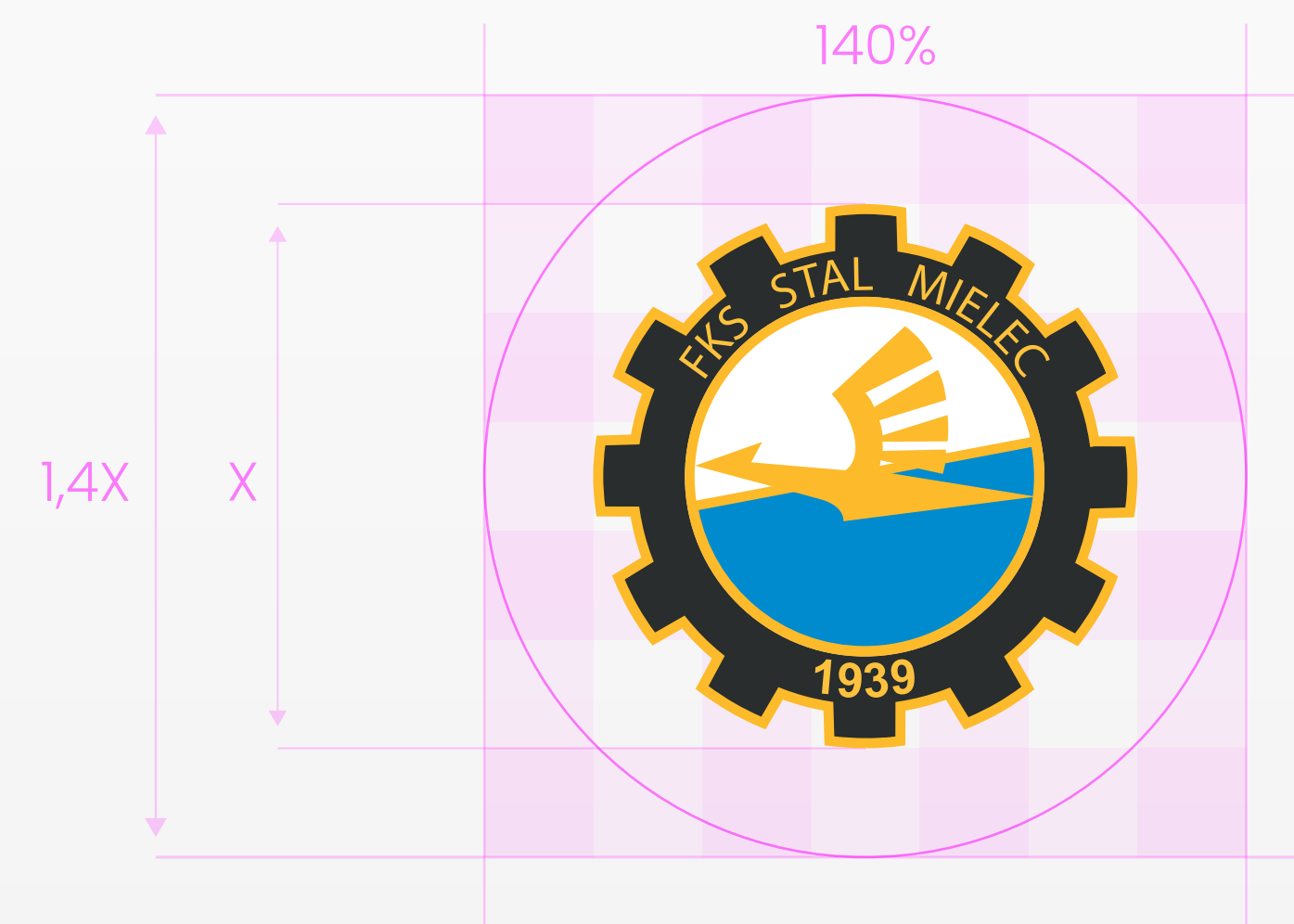
The FKS Stal Mielec crest is rich in symbolism that reflects both the industrial character of the city of Mielec and its links with aviation, as well as the history and traditions of the sports club. Elements such as a cogwheel, a crane, lettering and the colors blue, white and gold create a coherent and recognizable symbol that is the pride of fans and residents of Mielec.

STANDARD VERSION OF THE SIGN



The basic version of the FKS Stal Mielec emblem is the main and most commonly used form of visual identification of the club. It is a basic element of the graphic identity and is used in most promotional, printed and digital materials.

THE PROTECTIVE FIELD



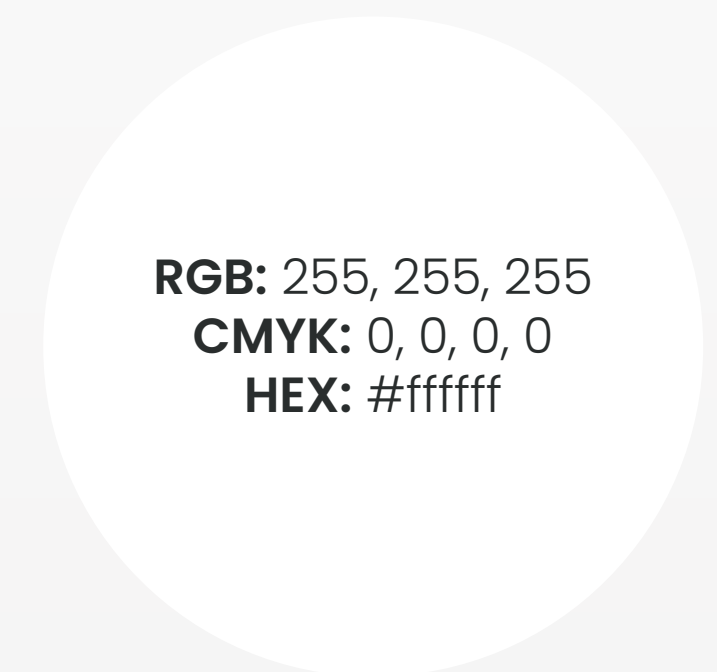
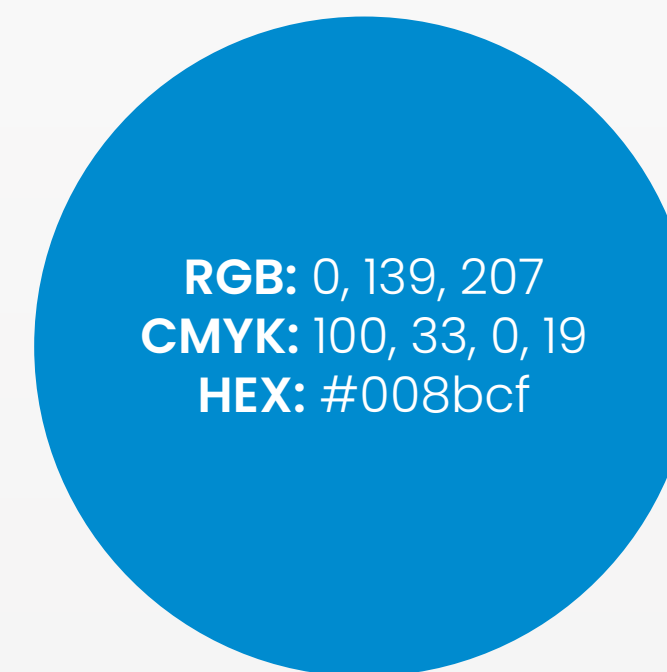
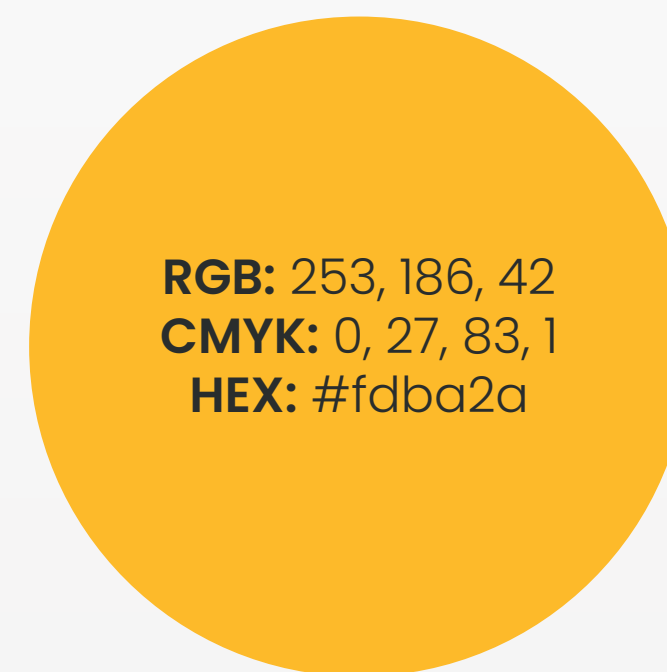
Calculating the protective area:

- The protective area is 140% (1.4 times) the height and width of the coat of arms.
- If the height and width of the coat of arms are X, then the protective area will be $1.4 \times X$ in height and width.

Protective field of the FKS Stal Mielec emblem to the area around the emblem, which should be freed from other graphic, textual or photographic elements. Ensuring an appropriate protective field, that the emblem of the discharge, legible and undisturbed by other visual elements.

For the FKS Stal Mielec emblem, the protective field available at 140% of the value of the club emblem itself. that the protective area around the emblem is equal to 1.4 times the height and width of the emblem. The protective field should be maintained in all views (top, bottom, left, right) around the emblem.

COLORS



The colours used in the crest have a deep symbolic meaning and are an integral part of the club's identity. The correct use of colours ensures visual consistency and recognition of the crest in various media and promotional materials.

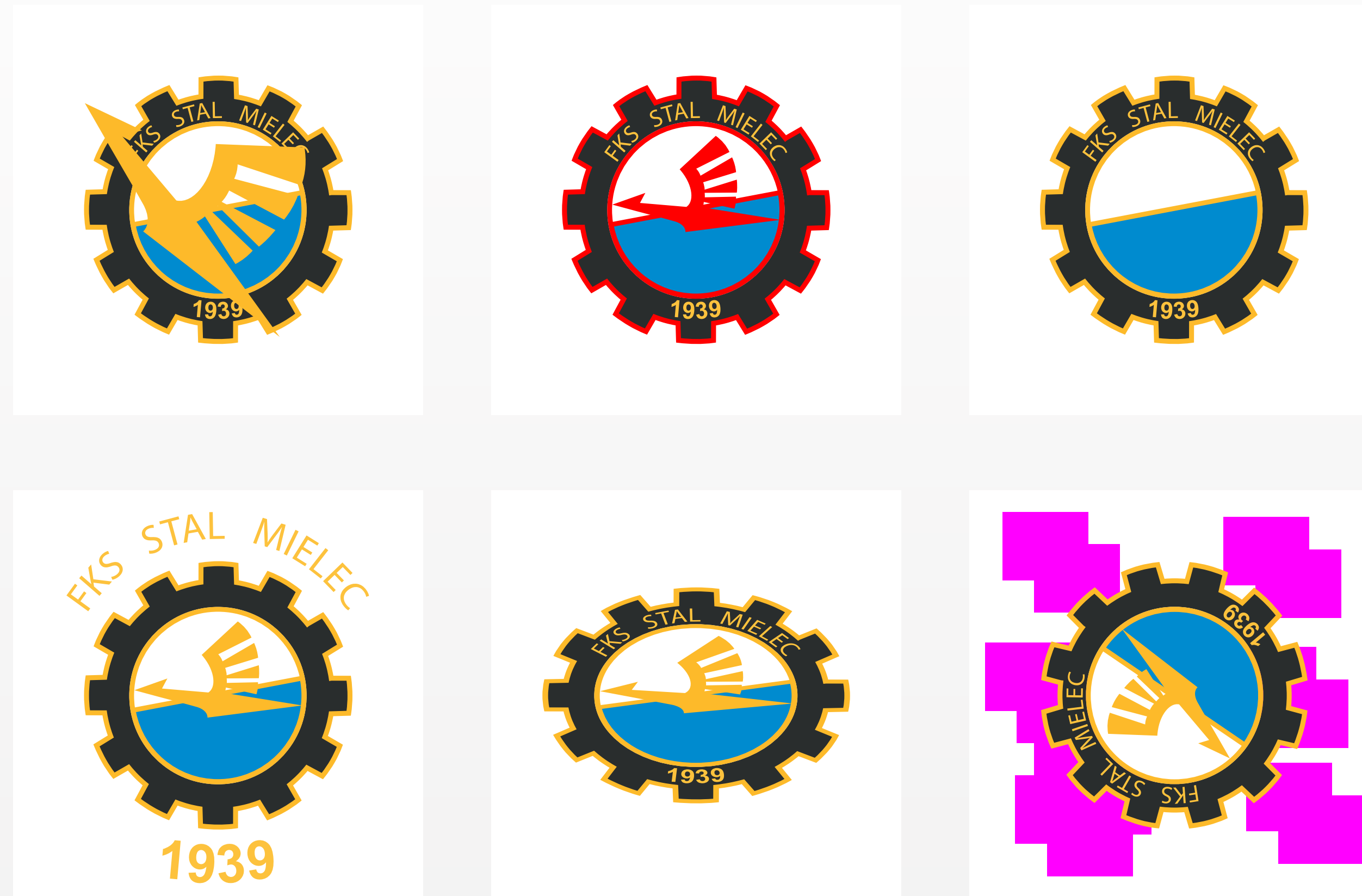
SIMPLIFIED VERSION OF THE SIGN

MONOCHROMATIC AND ACHROMATIC



The simplified version of the FKS Stal Mielec coat of arms is available in two variants: monochromatic and achromatic. These versions are used in situations where the full-color coat of arms cannot be used for technical or aesthetic reasons. The use of the simplified symbol ensures visual consistency and maintains the readability and recognizability of the coat of arms in various contexts.

UNACCEPTABLE MODIFICATIONS



In order to maintain the authenticity of the coat of arms and prevent unauthorized modifications, there are guidelines for unacceptable modifications.

Types of unacceptable modifications:

- Changing the shape of elements
- Changing the color scheme
- Adding or removing elements
